

Dear Customer

Re: A50 River Dove bridge maintenance scheme

We'll be carrying out work to maintain the bridge that runs over the River Dove along the A50 Doveridge Bypass. Our work will include safety barrier repairs, carriageway resurfacing and waterproofing, roadmaking renewal and bridge joint replacement. The completed work will provide a safer road whilst reducing the need for future maintenance.

Our work will take place from **2 June to 18 July 2025** under the following traffic management:

2 June – 8pm to 5am – full westbound carriageway closure between Ashbourne Interchange and Derby Road Roundabout.

4 June – 8pm to 5am – full eastbound carriageway closure Derby Road Roundabout and Ashbourne Interchange.

5 June to 16 July – 24/7 – contraflow system in both directions over the River Dove (approximately 200 metre stretch – please below map).

16 July – 8pm to 5am – full westbound carriageway closure between Ashbourne Interchange and Derby Road Roundabout.

18 July – 8pm to 5am – full eastbound carriageway closure between Derby Road Roundabout and Ashbourne Interchange.
